

Answers to Frequently Asked Renewal Questions

Ensure your chapter is providing up-to-date information by reviewing these frequently asked questions members ask about renewal.

Q: How long will I be considered a member?

A: You must pay annual membership fees to receive member benefits and publications. However, individuals can only be inducted into STTI once; therefore, if you let your membership lapse at any time, you will need to reactivate your membership to once again receive member benefits. You will not be inducted again.

Q: Why do I have to pay chapter and international dues?

A: Dues allow STTI and the chapter to provide benefits to each member. Each year, you will pay international dues as well as dues for the chapter(s) you belong to. You may belong to as many chapters as you would like.

Q: Are there special considerations for members who are retired or full-time students?

A: Yes, at the time of renewal, members who are retired or full-time students are entitled to pay half of the chapter and international membership fees. Student rates do not apply at the time of induction.

Q: I cannot afford to renew my membership right now. What will happen?

A: You will become an inactive member of STTI and will no longer receive member benefits and publications. If you need financial assistance, submit an STTI Edith Anderson Membership Subsidy application at www.nursingsociety.org/membership.

Q: What does STTI do to remind members of their upcoming renewals?
